

OFFICE ORDER

Bhubaneswar dated the 20th April, 2015

No.SER1-IAS-0017/2015-9843 /AIS.I., The Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure have issued orders regarding payment of one additional dose of Dearness Allowance i.e. from the existing rate of 107% to 113% with effect from 01.01.2015 to all Central Government Employees vide their Office Memorandum No.1/2/2015-E.II(B) dtd.10.04.2015. In view of the provisions contained in Rule 3 of the All India Services (Dearness Allowance) Rules, 1972, Members of All India Services are entitled to get the Dearness Allowance at the following revised rates as specified in the above cited Office Memorandum of Government of India, Ministry of Finance. The State Government in Finance Department vide their Office Memorandum No. 12410/F dtd. 20.04.2015 have released this additional dose of D.A. in favour of the State Government employees.

2. The State Government have decided that the additional dose of 6% Dearness Allowances on pay and Grade Pay taken together shall be released in favour of the Members of All India Services working in connection with the affairs of the State Government w.e.f. 01.01.2015 and shall be drawn in cash in the pay bill of April, 2015 payable in May, 2015 and onwards. Arrears of this enhanced D.A. from the month of January, 2015 to March, 2015 shall not be drawn before the date of disbursement of salary of April, 2015.

01.01.2015	113% on Pay & G.P.

3. This additional dose of D.A. shall be applicable to the members of All India Services, who were in service on the 1st January, 2015.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Payment of Dearness Allowance to Central Government employees - Revised Rates effective from 1.1.2015.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. 1/2/2014-E-II (B) dated 18th September, 2014 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance payable to Central Government employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 107% to 113% with effect from 1st January, 2015.

2. The provisions contained in paras 3, 4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M. No. 1(3)/2008-E-II(B) dated 29th August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.

3. The additional installment of Dearness Allowance payable under these orders shall be paid in cash to all Central Government employees.

4. These orders shall also apply to the civilian employees paid from the Defence Services Estimates and the expenditure will be chargeable to the relevant head of the Defence Services Estimates. In regard to Armed Forces personnel and Railway employees, separate orders will be issued by the Ministry of Defence and Ministry of Railways, respectively.

5. In so far as the employees working in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued with the concurrence of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
