**THE ORISSA OFFICIAL LANGUAGE
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1963**

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ORISSA OFFICIAL LANGUAGE
ACT, 1954

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Fourteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title 1. This Act may be called the Orissa Official Language (Amendment) Act, 1963.

Insertion of new section 3-A, Orissa Act 14 of 1954. 2. After section 3 of the Orissa Official Language Act, 1954, the following new section shall be inserted, Orissa Act, 14 of 1954
namely :—

Continuance of English language for use in Legislature. “3-A. Notwithstanding the expiration of the period of fifteen years from the commencement of the Constitution of India, the English language may, as from the 26th day of January 1965, continue to be used, in addition to Oriya for the transaction of business in Legislature of the State of Orissa.”
