RESOLUTION

Sub: Guidelines relating to engagement of retired Government Functionaries.

No. 2R/1-27/2003 31998 /Gen., Government have been pleased to decide that merit alone should determine tenures of Directors of Board of Directors of Public Enterprises, Presidents and Vice-Presidents of State Academies and there should be no age bar for such appointments. Accordingly, General Administration Department Resolution No. 19637/Gen., dt. 30.6.99 is amended to the extent as follows:

1. In Clause (b) of Para 3 of the said resolution, the following shall be substituted namely :

There would be no age bar for honorary appointments for specified periods of retiring/retired Government officers as Directors of Board of Directors of Public Enterprises or Presidents/Vice-Presidents of State Academies, provided that the persons to be appointed have good health and are fit.

ORDERS: Ordered that the resolution be published in the extraordinary, issue in the Orissa Gazette and copies thereof be forwarded to all concerned.
