NOTIFICATION

No. 32515—SC-H-5/2002-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Services of Assistants and Section Officers in the Offices of the Heads of Departments) Rules, 1994, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Services of Assistants and Section Officers in the Offices of the Heads of Departments) Amendment Rules, 2003.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*

2. In the Orissa Ministerial Services (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Services of Assistants and Section Officers in the Offices of the Heads of Departments) Rules, 1994 for clause (g) of sub-rule (1) of rule 2, the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

“(g) ‘Heads of Departments’ means a Head of Department as defined in rule 20 of the Orissa Service Code and enlisted in Appendix-3, thereof. Provided that the office of the Board of Revenue and its Constituent Heads of Departments specified hereunder shall constitute a single cadre under the administrative control of the Member, Board of Revenue who shall exclusively function as the Head of the Department of the said constituent Heads of Departments;

- (i) Office of the Special Relief Commissioner;
- (ii) Office of the Commissioner, Land Records and Settlements;
- (iii) Office of the Land Reforms Commissioner;
- (iv) Office of the Commissioner, Consolidation I and II;
- (v) Office of the Commissioner, Consolidation and Settlement;
- (vi) Office of the Director of Land Records and Surveys;
- (vii) Office of the Director of Consolidation;
- (viii) Office of the Inspector-General of Registration; and
- (ix) Office of the Excise Commissioner.”
